THE CROPS ACT (CAP 318)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Crops Act, CAP 318 the Cabinet Secretary for Agriculture and Livestock Development in consultation with the Authority and the County Governments, makes the following Regulations: -

THE CROPS (FIBRE CROPS AND CROP FIBRES) REGULATIONS, 2025

PART I - PRELIMINARY

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Crops (Fibre Crops and Crop Fibres) Regulations, 2025.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-

CAP 318

"Act" means the Crops Act, CAP 318;

"collection centre" means a premise designated close to growers for bulking of fibre produce or fibre product for purposes of collective marketing and enforcement of quality standards;

CAP 317

"Authority" means the Agriculture and Food Authority established under Section 3 of the Agriculture and Food Authority Act, CAP 317;

"competent authority" means an entity given legal authority to grading, testing or classing of fibre by the respective government or an accredited laboratory.

"cotton lint classing" means assessing the quality of cotton lint;

"cottage manufacture" means processing of fibre produce and fibre product in a factory with a gross turnover of KES 5,000,000 and below per year;

"county executive committee member" means County Executive Committee Member responsible for Agriculture;

"crop fibre" means fibre produced from primary processing of a scheduled crop;

"crop inspector" means an Officer appointed in accordance with section 27 of the Act;

"dealer" means a person who collects, aggregates, transports, stores, retails, manufactures, exports or imports a fibre produce or fibre product;

"Directorate" means the directorate established pursuant to section 11 of the Agriculture and Food Authority Act, CAP 317, that is responsible for matters related to fibre crops and crop fibres;

"fibre crop" means a scheduled crop grown primarily for purposes of producing fibre;

"fibre crop grower" means a person who cultivates fibre crop in Kenya;

"fibre produce" means the harvest from a fibre crop or part of other scheduled crop intended to produce fibre;

"fibre product" means output of processing of fibre produce and in the case of;

- (a) cotton includes cotton lint, cotton seed for milling and derived products, cotton linters, cotton yarn, cotton linters pulp, cotton waste and cotton yarn waste;
- (b) sisal includes sisal fibre, derived products from sisal pole, sisal yarn, sisal twine, sisal cordage, sisal rope and sisal textile;
- (c) jute includes jute fibre, jute twine, jute rope, jute yarn, jute cordage, jute cloth and textile;
 - (d) fibre from any other scheduled crop under the Act;

"grower association" means an organization formed by growers and include association, co-operative society, company, farmers' group or cooperative union;

"large scale manufacture" means processing of fibre produce or fibre product in a factory with a gross turnover of more than KES 5,000,000 per year;

"licensing authority" means the Authority or the county government as the case may be.

"manufacture" means decorticating, ginning, retting, brushing, spinning, milling, baling or packaging;

"premise" means a building used for aggregating, storing and manufacturing of fibre produce or fibre product;

"smallholder grower" means a grower who cultivates less than one hundred acres under perennial fibre crop or less than ten acres under annual fibre crop.

Purpose of these Regulations.

3. The purpose of these Regulations is the development and promotion of production, processing, and marketing of fibre crops, fibre produce or fibre products and regulation of fibre crops and crop fibre industry.

Scope of application of these Regulations.

- 4. These Regulations shall apply to-
 - (a) development and promotion of fibre crops, fibre produce and fibre products;
 - (b) procedures and conditions for registration, licensing and compliance of dealers;
- (c) standards and quality assurance of fibre crops, fibre produce and fibre products;
- (d) collection and maintenance of data related to fibre crops, fibre produce and fibre products;
- (e) conduct of inspections and compliance aspects;

- (f) determination of the pricing formula of fibre produce and fibre products;
- (g) marketing of fibre produce and fibre products;
- (h) grading of fibre produce and fibre products;
- (i) agreement between grower and dealer; and
- (j) issuance of certificates, licenses and permits for dealing in fibre produce and fibre products.

PART II - REGISTRATION AND LICENSING

Growers and grower association register

- 5. (1) A grower association shall maintain a register of all smallholder growers registered with it in Form COUNTY/C1 as set out in the Third Schedule.
- (2) The register referred to in sub-regulation 5(1) shall contain the annual production data of the smallholder growers therein.
- (3) A grower association shall submit annual returns of the smallholder fibre crops growers registered with it to the respective County Executive Committee Member and the Authority, in Form COUNTY/C1 as set out in the Third Schedule by the fifteenth day of January of every year.
- (4) The respective County Executive Committee Member shall maintain a register of all fibre crops growers and grower associations in Form COUNTY/C2 as set out in the Third Schedule.
- (5) A grower association shall notify the respective County Executive Committee, in writing, of any change in particulars of the smallholder growers contained in the register maintained under sub-regulation 5(3) within thirty days.

Inspection for Certificate of Compliance

- 6. (1) A person shall not operate an aggregation store or manufacture fibre product without a valid certificate of compliance from the Authority.
 - (2) A person who intends to operate an aggregation store or manufacture fibre product and has met the requirements as set out in the Sixth Schedule shall apply for inspection for certificate of compliance using Form AFA/FCD/A1 as set out in the First Schedule accompanied by the fee prescribed in the Eighth Schedule.
- (3) The Authority shall within fourteen days, inspect the aggregation store or the manufacturing factory and issue an inspection report in Form AFA/FCD/C1 as set out in the Third Schedule.
- (4) Subject the outcome of the inspection report in sub regulation 6(3), the Authority shall issue a certificate of compliance in Form AFA/FCD/B1 as set out in the Second Schedule to applicant whose inspection report has sufficient grounds to ensure compliance.
- (5) A certificate of compliance issued under this regulation shall be valid until the thirtieth of June immediately following the date of issue unless earlier cancelled.

- (6) An existing operator of an aggregation store or manufacturer shall apply for inspection for certificate of compliance at least thirty days before expiry of the current certificate.
- (7) A manufacturer issued with a certificate of compliance shall be deemed to be dully registered.
- (8) The Authority shall maintain and share with the respective County Executive Committee Member a register of all aggregation stores and manufacturing factories issued with certificates of compliance.
 - (9) A person who contravenes sub regulation 6(1) commits an offence.

Registration of an aggregator

- 7. (1) A person who intends to aggregate and operate a fibre produce or fibre product aggregation store, shall register as an aggregator with the respective County Executive Committee Member.
- (2) A person in sub regulation 7(1) shall apply for registration in Form COUNTY/A1 as set out in the First Schedule.
- (3) The respective County Executive Committee Member shall consider the application made under sub-regulation 7(2) and within fourteen days of receiving the application, issue to a successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a certificate of registration or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) An applicant whose application has been rejected in sub regulation 7(3) may within seven days resubmit the application after addressing the reasons raised in the rejection.
- (5) Upon resubmission of a satisfactory application under sub-regulation 7(4), the respective County Executive Committee Member shall issue the applicant a certificate of registration within seven days.
- (6) The respective County Executive Committee Member shall issue a registration certificate under this regulation in Form COUNTY/B1 as set out in the Second Schedule.

Designation of aggregation store

8. The aggregation stores issued with certificates of compliance shall stand designated for purposes of consolidating fibre produce or fibre products.

Licensing of an aggregator

- 9. (1) A person shall not aggregate fibre produce or fibre product without an aggregator license from the respective County Government.
- (2) A person intending to aggregate fibre produce or fibre product shall apply for a license in Form COUNTY/A2 as set out in the First Schedule accompanied by the fee prescribed in the Eighth Schedule
- (3) The applicant in sub-regulation 9(2) shall specify the aggregation store where growers will deliver their produce or product.

- (4) The respective County Executive Committee Member shall consider the application made under sub regulation 9(3) and within thirty days of receiving the application, issue to successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a license or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (5) The respective County Executive Committee Member shall issue a license under this regulation in Form COUNTY/B2 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (6) A licensed fibre produce or fibre product aggregator shall submit monthly returns by the fifteenth day of every month to the respective County Executive Committee Member and the Authority in Form COUNTY/C3 as set out in the Third Schedule.
 - (7) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 9(1) commits an offence.

Setting up a manufacturing factory

- 10. (1) A person shall not set up a fibre product manufacturing factory without a preliminary approval from the Authority except for cottage manufacturing.
- (2) A person who intends to set up a fibre product manufacturing factory shall make an application for a preliminary approval in Form AFA/FCD/A2 as set out in the First Schedule.
- (3) The Authority in consultation with the respective County Executive Committee Member shall consider the application made under sub-regulation 10(2) and within sixty days of receiving the application, issue to a successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a preliminary approval or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) The Authority shall issue a preliminary approval under this regulation in Form AFA/FCD/B2 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (5) The preliminary approval issued in sub regulation 10(4) shall authorize the applicant to proceed with setting up of the manufacturing factory.
- (6) Upon completion of the factory, the applicant shall apply to the Authority for a certificate of compliance under Regulation 6.
 - (7) A person who contravenes sub regulation 10(1) commits an offence.

Licensing of cottage fibre product manufacturer

- 11. (1) A person shall not operate a cottage fibre product manufacture without a certificate of compliance from the Authority and a license from the respective County Government.
- (2) A person who intends to manufacture fibre product in sub-regulation 11(1) shall apply for a license in Form COUNTY/A2 as set out in the First Schedule accompanied by the fee prescribed in the Eighth Schedule.

- (3) The County Executive Committee Member shall consider the application made under sub- regulation 11(2) and within fourteen days of receiving the application, issue to a successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a license or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) The County Executive Committee Member shall issue a license under this regulation in Form COUNTY/B3 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (5) The respective County Executive Committee Member shall maintain a register of licensed cottage manufacturers.
- (6) A licensed cottage fibre product manufacturer shall submit monthly returns by the fifteenth day of every month to the respective County Executive Committee Member and Authority the in Form COUNTY/C4 as set out in the Third Schedule.
 - (7) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 11(1) commits an offence.

Licensing of large scale fibre product manufacturer

- 12. (1) A person shall not operate a large scale fibre product manufacture without a license from the Authority.
- (2) A person who intends to manufacture fibre product in sub-regulation 12(1) shall apply for a license in Form AFA/FCD/A3 as set out in the First Schedule accompanied by the fee prescribed in the Eighth Schedule.
- (3) The Authority shall consider the application made under sub-regulation 12(2) and within fourteen days of receiving the application, issue to a successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a license or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) The Authority shall issue a license under this regulation in Form AFA/FCD/B3 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (5) The Authority shall maintain a register of licensed large scale manufacturers.
- (6) A licensed large scale fibre product manufacturer shall submit monthly returns by the fifteenth day of every month to the Authority and to the respective County Executive Committee Member in Form AFA/FCD/COUNTY/C4 as set out in the Third Schedule.
- (7) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 12(1) commits an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding ten million shillings or to imprisonment for term not exceeding five years, or both.

Registration of exporter and importer

- 13. (1) A person shall not export or import fibre product unless registered with the Authority.
 - (2) A person intending to export or import fibre product shall apply for registration in Form AFA/FCD/A3 as set out in the First Schedule.

- (3) The Authority shall consider an application made under sub-regulation 13(2) and within fourteen days of receiving the application, issue to a successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a certificate of registration or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) The Authority shall issue a certificate of registration under this regulation in Form AFA/FCD/B3 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (5) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 13(1) commits an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding five million shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years, or both.

Licensing of exporter and importer

- 14. (1) A person shall not export or import fibre product without a license from the Authority.
- (2) A person intending to export or import fibre product shall apply for a license in Form AFA/FCD/A4 as set out in the First Schedule accompanied by the fee prescribed in the Eighth Schedule.
- (3) The Authority shall consider the application made under sub-regulation 14(2) and within thirty days of receiving the application, issue to a successful applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a license or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) The Authority shall issue a license under this regulation in Form AFA/FCD/B4 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (5) Every licensed exporter and importer shall submit monthly returns by the fifteenth day of every month to the Authority in Form AFA/FCD/C2 as set out in the Third Schedule.
- (6) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 14(1) commits an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding ten million shillings or to imprisonment not exceeding five years or both.

Export and import permit

- 15.(1) A person shall not export or import fibre product without a permit from the Authority for each consignment.
- (2) A person intending to export or import fibre product shall apply for a permit in Form AFA/FCD/A5 as set out in the First Schedule.
 - (3) The application made in sub regulation 15(2) shall be accompanied with a payment of;
 - (a) an inspection service fee of zero point five percent Freight on Board (FOB) in the case of export of crop fibres.
 - (b) a re-baling fee of one thousand shillings per bale where re-baling service is required by the applicant.
- (4) The Authority shall consider the application made under sub regulation 15(2) and (3) and within two days of receiving the application, issue to a successful

applicant who has complied with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule a permit or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.

- (5) The Authority shall issue a permit under this regulation in Form AFA/FCD/B5 as set out in the Second Schedule.
- (6) A person who contravenes sub regulation 15(1) commits an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for term not exceeding one year, or both.

Renewal of License

- 16. (1) A license issued under these Regulations shall be valid until the thirtieth of June immediately following the date when it was issued unless earlier cancelled.
- (2) An application for renewal of a license shall be made in the same manner as the application for a new license.
- (3) An application for renewal of a license shall comply with the requirements set out in the Sixth Schedule.
- (4) An application for renewal of a license shall be made at least thirty days before expiry of the current license.

Late application fee

17. The licensing authority as the case may be, may consider late license renewal application and upon approval of such application, the applicant shall pay a late license renewal fee of ten percent of the license fee.

PART III - STANDARDS AND QUALITY ASSURANCE

Obligations of a grower

- 18. (1) Every grower shall adhere to applicable national, regional and international standards and codes of practice in the cultivation of fibre crops and handling of fibre produce.
 - (2) Every grower shall only harvest physiologically mature fibre produce.
- (3) Every grower shall grade fibre produce before offering for sale in accordance with the Fifth Schedule.
- (4) Every grower shall offer for sale fibre produce at collection centre operated by a person who is registered under Regulation 7 or as indicated in the agreement between a grower and a dealer.

Obligations of a dealer

- 19. (1) Every dealer shall adhere to the existing national, regional and international standards and codes of practice.
- (2) A dealer shall only buy, store, sell and offer for sale fibre produce or fibre product at designated aggregation store.
 - (3) A dealer operating an aggregation store shall-

- (a) conspicuously display the prices offered per kilogram of each grade of fibre produce and fibre product in the local dialect, Kiswahili and English, whenever the store is open for business;
- (b) display standard sample grades of fibre produce and fibre product and the corresponding price for each grade;
- (c) use weighing scales that have been properly calibrated and serviced;
- (d) issue original receipt for fibre produce and fibre product received from growers and retain the duplicate receipt;
- (e) offer to the growers a fibre produce or fibre product price as determined by the Fibre Produce and Fibre Product Pricing Formula within a period specified in the Fourth Schedule and
- (4) A dealer operating a fibre product manufacturing factory may only install additional processing capacity or vary the type of manufacturing with prior approval from the Authority.
- (5) A dealer shall package fibre produce or fibre product only in accordance with these Regulations.
- (6) A dealer shall grade fibre produce or fibre product in accordance with regulation 21 and 22.
- (7) A dealer shall not mix fibre produce or fibre product unless they are of the same grade.
 - (8) A dealer shall ensure that there is no fibre produce or fibre product contamination.

Traceability of fibre produce and fibre product

- 20.(1) A dealer in fibre produce and fibre product shall declare to the licensing authority the source of fibre produce or fibre product.
- (2) Every dealer shall comply to the traceability system prescribed by the Authority in consultation with industry stakeholders to trace the history and location of production, processing and distribution stages of fibre produce and fibre product.
- (3) Information on source of fibre produce or fibre product shall be shared between the licensing authorities on need basis.

Packaging and labelling

- 21. (1) Fibre product manufacturer shall package and label product legibly and indelibly.
- (2) Packaging and labelling of bales under sub-regulation 21(1) shall indicate-
 - (a) name of the fibre product;
 - (b) grade of the fibre product;

- (c) country of origin of the fibre product;
- (d) bale number of the fibre product;
- (e) lot number of the fibre product;
- (f) year of harvest of the fibre produce; and
- (g) net weight in kilograms.
- (3) The ink used in labeling under sub-regulation 21(1) shall not penetrate to the fibre product to avoid contamination.
- (4) Packaging of crop fibres shall be done in accordance with specific Kenya Standard crop fibre industry codes of practice including Cotton Industry Codes of Practice (KS 2857) and Sisal Industry Codes of Practice (KS 2858).

Grading and validation

- 22. (1) A grower or dealer shall grade all fibre produce and fibre product in accordance with the grades set out in the Fifth Schedule.
- (2) A person who intends to validate the grade of a fibre produce or fibre product shall-
 - (a) apply to the Authority for grade validation in Form AFA/FCD/A6 as set out in the First Schedule; and
 - (b) submit samples of fibre produce or fibre product to the Authority.
- (3) The Authority shall consider the application made under sub regulation 22(2)(a) and within seven days of receiving the application and the sample, issue to a successful applicant a report or reject the application and indicate the reasons thereof.
- (4) The Authority shall issue a report under sub-regulation 22(4) specifying the results of the analysis and the recommended grade of the samples delivered in Form AFA/FCD/C3 as set out in the Third Schedule.

Classing of cotton lint.

- 23. (1) A competent authority shall class cotton lint as set out in the Fifth Schedule.
- (2) A manufacturer shall not sell cotton lint that has been ginned unless the lint has been classed by a competent authority.
- (3) An exporter shall not export cotton lint unless it has been classed by a competent authority.
- (4) An importer of cotton lint shall not import cotton lint unless the lint has been classified by a competent authority.

- (5) An application for cotton lint classing under sub regulation 23(2) and (4) shall be made in Form AFA/FCD/A7 set out in the First Schedule accompanied with cotton lint sample and payment of Kenya Shillings three hundred per sample.
- (6) Upon receiving samples submitted under sub regulation 23(5) the competent authority shall;
 - (a) within seven days, conduct a test of the samples and issue a classing report to the applicant in Form AFA/FCD/C4 set out in the Third Schedule.; or
 - (b) reject the samples giving reasons of the rejection in writing to the applicant.

Prohibition against adulteration.

- 24. (1) A person shall not adulterate fibre produce or fibre product.
 - (2) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 23(1) commits an offence.

PART IV - TRADE AND MARKETING

Purchase of fibre produce and fibre product

- 25. (1) A dealer shall purchase fibre produce and fibre product at a minimum price determined by the pricing formula developed by the Fibre Produce and Fibre Product Pricing Formula Committee established under regulation 26(1).
 - (2) A person who contravenes sub-regulations 25(1) commits an offence.

Fibre Produce and Fibre Product Pricing Formula Committee

- 26. (1) There is established a Fibre Produce and Fibre Product Pricing Formula Committee.
- (2) The Fibre Produce and Fibre Product Pricing Formula Committee shall consist of the following persons appointed by the Cabinet Secretary-
 - (a) one representative from the state department responsible for matters relating to crops who shall be the chairperson;
 - (b) one person nominated by the state department responsible for matters relating to trade;
 - (c) one person nominated by the Authority;
 - (d) one person nominated by the Council of Governors;
 - (e) two smallholder growers nominated by grower associations
 - (f) one representative nominated by plantation growers;
 - (g) one representative nominated by cottage manufacturers;
 - (h) one representative nominated by large scale manufacturers; and

- (i) one representative nominated by fibre product spinners;
- (3) The Cabinet Secretary while appointing members in sub regulation 26(2)(e), (f), (g), (h) and (i) shall consider representation from the various fibre crop and crop fibre value chains, gender, youth, persons living with disabilities and regional balance.
- (4) The Committee shall be responsible for the development of the pricing formula for fibre crops produce and fibre crop products.
- (5) In determining the formula under sub regulation 26(4) the Committee, shall consider:
 - (a) supply and demand forces;
 - (b) the cost of production;
 - (c) fibre quality parameters;
 - (d) revenue sharing between actors along the value chain;
 - (e) percentage value of by products; and
 - (f) any other prevailing factors.
- (6) The Fibre Produce and Fibre Product Pricing Formula Committee shall review the formula developed in regulation 26(4) on need basis to provide for continuous improvement.
- (7) The persons appointed under sub regulation 26(2) shall serve for a term of two years but shall, subject to satisfactory performance be eligible for re-appointment for one further term of two years.
 - (8) The persons appointed under sub regulation 26(2) may vacate office-
 - (a) by resignation in writing addressed to the Cabinet Secretary;
 - (b) the written recommendation of the body which the member represents revoking the nomination of that member;
 - (c) if the member is absent without permission of the chairperson for three consecutive meetings of the Committee of which the member has received notice;
 - (d) if the Committee determines that the member is incapable of performing the duties by reason of mental or physical infirmity;
 - (e) upon adjudication or admission of bankruptcy; or
 - (f) upon conviction for an offence relating to corruption or contravention of Chapter Six of the Constitution and sentenced for

a term exceeding six months' imprisonment without an option of a fine.

- (9) The business and affairs of the Committee shall be as set out in the Seventh Schedule.
 - (10) The Authority shall be the Secretariat to the Committee.

Agreement between grower and dealer

- 27. (1) A registered grower may enter into agreement with a dealer.
- (2) The agreement entered into in accordance with sub-regulation 27(1) shall be as set out in the Fourth Schedule.
- (3) A person who intends to support the production of fibre crops or crop fibres shall enter into an agreement with a grower or grower association.
- (4) A copy of the agreement entered into in accordance with sub-regulation 27(1) shall be deposited with the respective County Executive Committee Member and the Authority.

PART V - INSPECTION AND COMPLIANCE

Appointment of Crop Inspector

- 28. (1) A Crop Inspector shall be appointed by the Authority in accordance with section 27 of the Act.
 - (2) A person qualifies to be appointed as a Crop Inspector if that person-
 - (a) is a Kenyan citizen;
 - (b) satisfies the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution;
 - (c) holds either-
 - (i) a diploma in agriculture or agriculture related field and a minimum of two years' relevant experience; or
 - (ii) a bachelor's degree in agriculture or agriculture related field from a recognized university and a minimum of one-year relevant experience; and
 - (d) has undergone relevant training on inspection.
 - (3) A County Executive Committee Member may nominate a qualified person for consideration and appointment as a Crop Inspector.
 - (4) The Authority may publish in the Gazette the Crop Inspector appointed under section 27 of the Act.

Inspection and surveillance

- 29. (1) A Crop Inspector shall-
 - (a) inspect grower field operations;

- (b) inspect fibre produce and fibre product facilities, handling, packaging, labelling, pricing, grading, sampling, units of measurement, fibre produce, fibre product and any equipment used thereof;
- (c) inquire for such information as deemed necessary from any person in relation to the production or dealing in fibre produce and fibre product;
- (d) enter any land, premises or vehicle, used by a grower or dealer of fibre produce or fibre product;
- (e) request for the production of a license, certificate or permit for examination;
- (f) seize and remove any article or thing which the inspector has reasonable grounds for believing that an offence under the Act or these Regulations is being or has been committed;
- (g) monitor and enforce compliance to these regulations, standards and codes of practice; and
- (h) carry out surveillance at entry points and in areas where fibre produce or fibre product is traded.
- (2) The owner, occupier or any person, on premises or a vehicle on which a crops inspector is conducting an inspection, shall render assistance as may be required by the inspector.
- (3) Inspections may be scheduled, impromptu or requested and where an application is required, the applicant shall apply to the Authority or to the respective County Executive Committee Member for inspection in Form AFA/FCD/COUNTY/A8 as set out in the First Schedule.
- (4) A crops inspector shall issue inspection report in Form AFA/FCD/COUNTY/C5 as set out in the Third Schedule after conducting an inspection in accordance with sub-regulation 29(1).
- (5) Where a Crop Inspector observes a non-compliance, the Inspector shall issue a seven days' notice to the affected person to carryout corrective action on the non-compliance and intention for suspension, or revocation of a license, certificate or permit in case the corrective action is not addressed.

Illegal manufacture and possession

- 30. (1) A person who is not registered and licensed in accordance with the Act and these Regulations shall not manufacture, buy, sell, transport, offer for sale or possess fibre produce or fibre product.
- (2) A person who contravenes sub-regulation 30(1) commits an offence and shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten million shillings, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years, or both.

PART VI - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Revocation and surrender of certificate, license or permit.

- 31. (1) The licensing authority may revoke a certificate, license or permit issued in accordance with these Regulations if-
 - (a) the holder fails to meet the conditions imposed on the certificate, license or permit;
 - (b) a certificate of compliance is cancelled or withdrawn.
 - (2) If the certificate of compliance is revoked, the license issued shall stand cancelled.
 - (3) The licensing authority shall not revoke a certificate, license or permit unless a notice of at least fourteen days of the intention to revoke is given
 - (4) If a certificate, license or permit is revoked, the holder shall immediately surrender it to the licensing authority and shall cease to have effect from the date of its revocation.
 - (5) A holder of a certificate, license or permit that has been revoked shall be given an opportunity to be heard on the revocation.
 - (6) The licensing authority may publish revoked certificate, license and permit.

Appeals

- 32.(1) An applicant or a holder of a certificate, license and permit who is aggrieved by a decision of the licensing authority on or in respect of-
 - (a) the grant, refusal, renewal, variation or revocation; or
 - (b) the conditions imposed on the grant, renewal or variation of a certificate, license or permit may appeal to the Cabinet Secretary for appeals against the Authority or to the County Executive Committee Member in case of County Government.
 - (2) An appeal under this regulation shall be lodged within thirty days from the date on which the appellant first received notice of the decision.
 - (3) The Cabinet Secretary or the County Executive Committee shall consider the request in Regulation 32(1) and deliver the decision to the affected parties within thirty days after receiving the request.

General penalty

33. A person who contravenes any provision of these Regulations, or commits an offence for which no penalty is prescribed, shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand shillings, or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both.

Imposition of levy

34. (1) There shall be levies imposed by the Cabinet Secretary as follows;

- (a) a person who intends to export fibre product shall pay zero point two five percent Freight on Board (FOB) value;
- (b) a person who intends to import semi processed fibre product shall pay two percent Cargo Insurance and Freight (CIF) value;
- (c) a person who intends to import finished fibre products shall pay four percent Cargo Insurance and Freight (CIF) value.
- (2) The levy imposed under sub regulation 34(1) shall be remitted to the Authority at the point of application of the requisite permit.
- (3) Any levy imposed under these regulations which remains unpaid shall be recovered by the Authority as a civil debt due to it from the person by whom it is payable
- (4) A person who fails, neglects or otherwise refuses to pay or remit the levy as provided under these regulations shall in addition to paying the levy, pay an interest at the prevailing market rate for the period the levy remains unpaid.

Transitional provision

35. Certificate, license and permit validly in force before the coming into operation of these Regulations shall remain valid until their expiry and the holder shall acquire any subsequent certificate, license and permit in accordance with these Regulations.

Colour of fibre may be brownish, spotted, yellowish or greenish. Black coloured fibre is not allowed in this grade because this shows that it is in the process of rotting (or rotten).
Uncarded Flume TOW	Fibre cuttings extracted from the flume channel and dried. It should be uniform in colour of creamy white to light brown. Devoid of undecorticated strips of sisal leaf, rotten fibre and foreign materials. It should be properly dried with a moisture content similar to other grades. Dust content not to exceed 15% when extracted by hand.

Carded Flume TOW	Fibre cuttings extracted from the flume channel and dried. It should be the same as un-carded flume tow except the total dust content not to exceed 10%
UHDS	Length 60 cm upwards and it is fibre which comes from unwashed hand, decorticated sisal. It can be brushed or not brushed and colour may be blemished, greenish, brownish and blackish but not rotten.

Note:

- (a) Grades 1, A, 2, 3L, 3, UG and SCWF to be of parallel packing, no ties or knots, free of dampness and excessive baling pressure.
- (b) The word "harshness" included in the definition of Grades 1, A, and 2 only refers to fibre from which the gum has not been sufficiently extracted by cleaning, and does not apply to fibre which is coarse in texture owing to soil or climatic conditions

2. SEED COTTON AND COTTON SEED GRADING DEFINITIONS

Grade A seed cotton - has no yellow stains from pest attack and excretions usually white and with minimum foreign matter.

Grade B seed cotton - yellow stained from pest attack and excretions usually not white.

Grade A cotton seed – seed from ginning of grade A seed cotton.

Grade B cotton seed – seed from ginning of grade B seed cotton.

3. COTTON LINT CLASSING

All cotton lint shall be classed by instrument testing describing the physical attributes of the lint in terms of length (L), strength (g/tex), micronaire, fibre uniformity (uniformity index), colour (Rd and +b) and colour grade (Grd).

4. MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR GRADING OTHER FIBRES

Grading of other fibre produce and fibre products shall consider colour, strength, length, trash levels, uniformity.
